The project started on January 15,2020 and will end on January 14,2023.

PROMENTORS Goals:

The main goal of PROMENTORS is to improve the quality of teacher training in Israel through an efficient and sustainable mentoring system based on best EU practices with their mentees. It is an the successful MIT models (Multiplayer Induction Team) that was developed in the now concluded PROTEACH ERASMUS+ project. The MIT models will serve as a basis for a new model of training reademic colleges in bracel. In the new models there will be training courses for in-service teachers and courses on different levels (Eds. and MEd.) that

will run pilot programs that enlarge the scope of the MTS in schools. PROMENTORS facilitates the collaboration of mentors, new teachers, pedagogical guides, and the school staff, in the process of professional development of mentors. 



GACE Syllabus course mentors - PROMENTORS

Course Rationale:

Mentoring procedures and guidance for new teaching workers have been established in recent years as part of the process of entering the profession of teaching. In order to establish professional initiation processes that best address the challenges faced by the new teacher and kindergarten teacher and to develop a proper strategy of absorbing new mentors into the education system, mentors must undergo training courses to provide them with the knowledge, skills and competencies to accompany their work. This online course is part of the training requirements of mentors who will be guardians of our teaching profession.

The uniqueness of this course is reflected in the fact that this course is a part of an ERASMUS+ international program called PROMENTORS. This project aims to create a professional training program for mentors. The website of this project is https://promentors.org/
