

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING TADEUSZ AND EWA KONOPACKI SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

1. The Scholarship Fund is established from a donation of USD 100,000 (one hundred thousand US Dollars) made by Mr. Tadeusz and Mrs. Ewa Konopacki to the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (KUL).
2. The aforementioned donation amount shall be placed in a long-term bank account providing high interest rate.
3. Interest from the account shall be used for student Scholarships.
4. Scholarships shall be awarded in a given academic year, on proviso that the amount of interest from the account are no less than PLN 1,000 (one thousand Polish Zloty) in accord with the relevant book record as of 31 October that academic year.
5. Scholarships shall be awarded to outstanding students of KUL who are Polish nationals, and who cumulatively meet the following eligibility criteria:
  - (a) they completed their first year of study at KUL;
  - (b) they record for the previous year of study minimally equals 4.000 – as a year average from all classes, lectures and examinations;
  - (c) they exhibit irreproachable Catholic attitude;
  - (d) they come from the countries of the former USSR, and in particular from Ukraine and Belarus, where they lived before studies at KUL.
6. The Scholarship may be withdrawn by Vice-rector for Student Support in the event of:
  - (a) failure to complete a semester or an academic year;
  - (b) withdrawal from studies at KUL;
  - (c) reprehensible attitude with disrespect to Catholic ideals;
  - (d) suspension of students' rights;
  - (e) removal from the list of students or relegation from KUL.
7. The decision to award Scholarship is made by the Commission for Funded Scholarships, chaired by the Vice-rector for student support.
